EXAMINATION STEPS AND PROCEDURES		
Takes or verbalizes body substance isolation precautions	1	
Expose Injury:		
Remove patient's clothes and expose injury	1	
Control Bleeding:		
Apply direct pressure over wound to control excessive bleeding	1	
Apply Dressing:		
Cover wound with sterile trauma dressing (pre-moistened with saline)	1	
Cover wet dressing with a dry trauma dressing	1	
Bandage or tape dressing securely in place	1	
Transport:		
Position of comfort (usually supine)	1	
Observe for shock, and treat if occurs	1
