Infant / Pediatric patient is positioned in the supine position	1	
Patient is measured by placing the end of the Broselow Tape with the arrow at the top of the head of the patient	1	
The Broselow Tape is stretched out and the heel of the patient should be placed in the color section of the tape	1
