<b>EXAMINATION STEPS AND PROCEDURES</b>		
Takes or verbalizes body substance isolation precautions	1	
<b>Assess Neurovascular Status:</b>		
Check distal pulse, motor function, sensation, and capillary refill (PMSC)	1	
<b>Immobilize Injury:</b>		
Observe for shortening and/or rotation (internal/external) on affected side	1	
Place patient onto backboard to limit movement	1	
Allow patient to flex knees for position of comfort	1	
Secure patient to backboard with straps or tape	1	
<b>Reassess Neurovascular Status:</b>		
Re-check distal pulse, motor function, sensation, and capillary refill (PMSC)	1
