EXAMINATION STEPS AND PROCEDURES		
Takes or verbalizes body substance isolation precautions	1	
Establish Airway:		
Use head-tilt / chin-lift maneuver	1	
Insert airway adjunct	1	
Apply Mask:		
Place apex of mask over bridge of nose	1	
Using both hands, place thumbs on apex and index fingers on the chin section of mask. Grasp mandible with last three fingers and pull upward to maintain an open airway. (E-C method)	1	
Maintain a good seal	1	
Ventilate:		
Take a breath and blow into the port of the mask		
Ventilate at a rate of 12-20 breaths / minute for an adult (1 breath every 5-6 seconds)	1	
Verify Ventilation's:		
Observe rise and fall of chest	1
