<b>EXAMINATION STEPS AND PROCEDURES</b>		
Takes or verbalizes body substance isolation precautions	1	
<b>Patient Positioning:</b>		
Place patient in the supine position	1	
Consider possible associated cervical spine injury with head injury	1	
<b>Bleeding Control:</b>		
Control profuse bleeding	1	
<b>Stabilize the object:</b>		
Place dressing around object and position fingers so that object will be stabilized	1	
Avoid movement of the object	1	
Stabilize the dressing with tape to secure object from possible movement	1	
Cover uninjured eye (explain reason why to patient)	1	
<b>Transport:</b>		
Transport carefully, to prevent movement of impaled object	1	
Observe for shock, and treat if occurs	1
