Skills Participation

The Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) skills in this notebook are required components for successful completion of the EMT course. Each student will be required to attend mandatory practice days offered throughout the semester and participate in all of the skill stations. There will be additional skills practice days scheduled on Saturday's during the course to help assure adequate practice time and extra assistance to all students. Each class will be assigned a morning or afternoon session to attend for skills demonstration and practice. It is very important for a student to have mastery of all these skills, due to the extreme demands and stressors that can be placed upon an EMT during an emergency call at all hours of a day. Through repetition and continuous practice a student will build confidence and competency to perform any skill when ever needed.

The Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) teachers at Baldy View Regional Occupational Program are dedicated in assisting and helping all students build their skill level through practice.
